Dear Northvale Community,

The Northvale Public Library is thrilled to announce we will begin offering curbside pickup for Northvale residents on Monday, June 22!

You may now request items online through the [BCCLS catalog](#) using your Northvale Library card and pin. Although requests may be placed for any item, we can only fill holds for Northvale items at this time. Requests for out-of-town items will remain pending on your account until BCCLS resumes full delivery service. If you aren't sure what you want to read or watch, call the library and staff will pull a few recommendations.

Requests for Northvale items will be eligible for pickup on or after Monday, June 22 during the library's outdoor contactless curbside pickup hours from 10:30 a.m.-5:30 p.m. Monday-Thursday and 10:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m. on Friday. You will receive notification through email, text or phone (depending on your account preferences) when one or more of your items are ready. Park in the designated pickup zone and call us at 201 768-4784. Staff will assist with your checkout and will bring your checked out item(s) in a bag and place on a table near designated parking zone. Please remain near your vehicle if driving or at a safe social distance until the pickup area is clear. Take your labeled bag and enjoy!

Our outdoor book drop is open for you to return any items currently checked out to your card at your convenience. Returns will be quarantined for 72+ hours and then checked in. There is no need to worry about fines since checked out materials have had their due dates automatically extended during closure.
